Facilitator-trainer-expert in Living Lab, Mr Stéphane SOYEZ joined the Catholic University of Lille in 2013 to take charge of the Ensembl learning unit (formerly "Les Ateliers Humanicité").

Previously, he contributed to the emergence of clusters, competitiveness clusters, or business clusters before becoming director and co-founder of Living Lab Autonom'lab, one of the first French Living Labs specializing in health.

The Ensembl unit trains students and employees of private and public companies in many sectors of activity in the Living Lab approach: agri-agro, banking and insurance, local authorities or state services, town planning, research, etc.

Also with the support of research teams from La Catho de Lille (ETHICS - EA 7446) and partners, Ensembl is implementing the Living Lab approach in three third places in the Lille metropolitan area. Ensembl supports and facilitates the co-development of projects of stakeholders in these territories, based on their needs, so that they become actors in the transformation of their ecosystem. Each of the third places develops a different theme: the Lab Humanicité (Humanicité district Capinghem/Lomme) on the theme of "living well together", the Lab Moulins (Lille south district - Moulins) on "well-aging-together", and finally at the zoological park of Lille on "better working together".
